The List of Nominations for the 2025 "For Fidelity to Science" Award

1. Scientific Press Service of the Year

Teams of press services of universities and research organizations are nominated for their systematic and high-quality work in covering scientific achievements, research projects conducted at the organization.

2. Science Journalist of the Year

The award in this category is presented to a professional journalist for outstanding service and significant contribution to the popularization of science and comprehensive media coverage of scientists' work.

3. Digital Content Author

The category is awarded to an author (blogger, TV presenter, online content creator) who has made a significant contribution to the popularization of science through the Internet and television.

4. Recognition Award

The award in this category is presented to outstanding individuals who have made significant contributions to the popularization of science and have become iconic figures for many generations.

5. Russian Science for the World (category in honor of Konstantin Tsiolkovsky)

This category recognizes international scientific and educational projects aimed at popularizing domestic science and higher education abroad, breaking stereotypes and forming an accurate picture of the achievements of Russian scientists in the world

6. Working with Experience: Scientists' Contribution to Victory

The award in this category is presented to an educational project aimed at preserving and popularizing reliable knowledge about outstanding Russian researchers, discoverers, and their contribution to the Victory in the Great Patriotic War.

7. Khristofor Ledentsov Special Award

The award is given to projects aimed at informing the public about the contribution of science to industry and strengthening the real sector of the economy, as well as other research projects in the field of business and government interaction.

8. Daniil Granin Special Award

The award is given for outstanding projects aimed at creating an artistic image of a scientist in various media formats.

The category recognizes science and education projects in any format aimed at popularizing science and technology among children and adolescents.

10. 80th Anniversary of the Atomic Industry Special Award
